Our 'Seasonal Charmers' allow us to share some of our favorites and some of the new wines we encounter from month to month; season to season. We always have our food in mind when selecting these wines so enjoy the selected food matches or try experimenting for yourself. Remember - an open mind and sense of experimentation is a wonderful thing!

WHITES & ROSE

Equipo Navazos 'I Think' *Spain, Manzanilla* 48

Manzanilla is Sherry but not as you know it, or at least as your Nanna used to! It is a fortified white wine aged under a 'veil' of yeast. The wine style is recognised for its salinity and nutty complexity. Keep your mind open and enjoy with a tin of anchovies

Villa Wolf Gewerztraminer 2016 *Pfalz, Germany* 42

This zesty off dry style is an 'any time of day wine' with delicious ripe yellow peach and orange blossom. For something different, try with the roasted cauliflower black truffle soup.

Keller 'Von der Fels' Riesling 2016 *Rhinehessen, Germany* 135

A genuine superstar from the Rhinehessen, Klaus Peter Keller since taking over his family's domaine in 2001 has forced the dry Rieslings of Germany into the spotlight. This wine meaning literally 'from the rocks' shows tropical fruit notes as well as savoury edge and has a chalky texture derived from the soil and rocks from where it's grown. Steamed asparagus and the truffled pecorino custard

Nick Spencer Gruner Veltliner 2018 *Tumbarumba, NSW* 52

Bloody good Aussie Gruner Veltliner if you ask me! Clean, no fuss yet interesting. Floral nose with layers of citrus moving into light marmalade. The mineral backbone keeps the wine together and the length is incredible.

Telmo Rodriguez 'Basa' Blanco 2017 *D.O Rueda, Spain* 50

D.O Rueda is a specialised white wine only D.O in North West Spain, Verdejo is the star variety, with native Viura & International Sauvignon Blanc also planted. This blanco is a fantastically refreshing blend of the three grapes with citrus, tropical fruits and a stoney minerality.

Domaine Tempier Rose 2016 *Bandol, France* 99

Arguably the worlds best Rose, it's about as complex, structured and age-worthy as a rose can be. Made from Mourvedre, Grenache & Cinsault it's floral and shows intense flavours of peach and pomegranate. Roasted Market Fish, Young Leeks and Saffron Butter

A funky new label from brothers Damon and Jonathan Koerner.
"Our winemaking philosophy is very simple - the wines are made in the vineyard. We attempt to produce wines to a style that we both enjoy drinking. Generally these wines are light, fresh, textured and well structured... with high drinkability in mind". - Jono
- Chateau Thivin 'Les Sept Vignes' 2016 *Beaujolais, France* 94
Gamay from the Cote de Brouilly. Absolutely sensational... that is all
- Ochota Barrels 'The Fugazi Vineyard' Grenache 2017 *McLaren Vale* 86
From a more than 70 year old vineyard grown in the sands of what should be recognised as Australia's Grand Cru region for Grenache, Blewitt Springs. Don't let the name fool you (Fugazi was a seminal punk rock band from the 80's & 90's) this wine is all class from beginning to end. Duck & Pinot are a classic pair but give this a try for something new
- Descendientes de J Palacois 'Petalos' 2016 *Bierzo, Spain* 99
Mencia is the grape, fresh, fragrant and deep are the wines. Think of a more savoury, earthy, glossy version of Shiraz and you're on the right wavelength. Try it with the Steak Fritte.
- Nocturne Cabernet Sauvignon 2016 *Margaret River* 78
A new player in Margaret River but for those of us who still love Cabernet this wine is detailed in its red and purple fruit profile but carries a good amount of richness and savoury bay leaf nuance. Cabernet & Lamb. How can you miss!?
- Vincent Paris Saint Joseph 'Les Cotes' 2016 *Rhone, France* 95
Syrah from a noted Rhone producer, these wines tend toward powerful and deep wines but they retain a degree of finesse and detail that elevate him to the top of the Rhone tree. Our Slow Roasted Lamb Shoulder show's all the power of flavour and detail in cooking to match sensationally.
- Yarra Yering 'Dry red NO.1' *Yarra Valley, VIC* 140
In true Yarra Yering tradition this wine combines power with poise, concentration and finesse. This medium bodied claret style is principally cabernet sauvignon with merlot, malbec and a little petit Verdot.
